



## Welcome to the Port Fairy Surf Life Saving Club

The Club boasts a modern building constructed in 2000. It has splendid views of the patrolled East beach and contains state-of-the-art surf life saving equipment.

Club activities include regular voluntary weekend and public holiday beach patrols from the start of December until Easter. During January paid lifeguards patrol the beach during weekdays. A Nipper programme involves teaching surf life saving awareness and water safety to children aged 6 to 13 years and runs during the summer holidays. At the end of each session Nippers enjoy a sausage sizzle in front of the clubhouse. The Club has a Youth Development Squad for training younger teenagers in life saving and competition skills. Older members are trained for various life saving awards including the Bronze Medallion. All members participate in surfboat, board, ski and beach events at Lifesaving Victoria Carnivals. It is a serious and fun loving Club.



Other Club activities include the Duck Derby on the Moyne River on New Year's Day and the 1.2km Moyneyana swim in early January.
